Dr Del Bufalo, PhD, has a long record of studies on tumor angiogenesis. In the last years her group has provided mechanistic insight on the bcl-2 and bcl-xL involvement on tumor metastasis and angiogenesis, and on the ability of antineoplastic drugs and molecular therapies to affect tumor angiogenesis. Another interest of Dr. Del Bufalo is the experimental chemotherapy of tumors. In vitro and in vivo studies have been performed to evaluate the efficacy of several antineoplastic, antiangiogenic and epigenetic drugs, and oligonucleotide antisenses as therapeutic agents able to induce apoptosis and/or autophagy.
