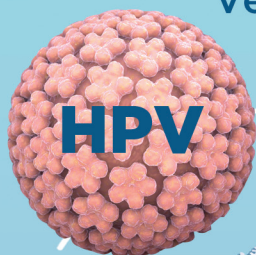


ITALY-BRAZIL MAECI PROJECT **Two-Day Symposium**

Scientific Programme



The WHO 90-70-90 strategy aims to eliminate cervical cancer by 2030 through widespread vaccination against HPV (90% of girls under fifteen), screening (at least twice in life for 70% of women) and treatment (90% of women with precancerous lesions and uterine cancer). This symposium will focus on these key areas: vaccine, screening and treatment. The symposium is the result of a long-standing collaboration between Italy and Brazil; in particular, between the IRCCS Regina Elena National Cancer Institute and the Federal University of Pernambuco. The MAECI and the Fundação de Amparo à Ciência e Tecnologia de Pernambuco have recently funded a "Project of Great Relevance" [Project BR22GR03] on the development of new therapeutic DNA vaccines. This symposium will present not only the results of this project, but also recent and comprehensive information on primary and secondary prevention, as well as new therapies against HPV and related cancers, including non-genital cancers.
